### **Immediate Report**

#### **Class action – Bezeq International**

On February 19, 2012, the subsidiary Bezeq International received notice of a financial claim together with an application for its certification as a class action, which was filed against it and against two other holders of licenses for providing international telecommunication services (together - "the Defendants") in the Tel Aviv District Court.

According to the applicant, the Defendants deceived customers who purchased from them overseas dialing services using pre-paid dialing cards, about the number of minutes on the card. (For information about a similar application filed against Bezeq International in 2008 concerning certain dialing cards, which was certified as a class action in November 2010, see section 4.20.1 in Chapter A - Description of the Corporation's Business, of the Company's 2010 Periodic Report.)

The amount claimed from Bezeq International (and from each of the other Defendants) in the name of the entire group, is estimated at NIS 2.7 billion.

Bezeq International is studying the claim, and neither it nor the Company is able, at this stage, to assess the likelihood of its success.
